- 3. Can international students apply for an internship? Isn't it the case that you can't work more than 20 hours on a Tier 4 visa? While international students are still completing their programme, they are subject to the normal 20 hour work limits. In practice, most internships (in the UK) are explicitly aimed at undergraduates. However, PGTs can plan to look for a period of temporary work to get experience after their coursework/dissertation/project is completed – which is what most "internships" really are.
