### PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any core courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- Maximum 20 credits at Level below (students at Level 3 are not normally permitted to take Level 1 credits)
- As a joint honours student, **you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject.** If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.

### HELPFUL HINTS:

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G RELT30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2

**Step 1:** You should choose **one** (40 credits) of the following optional core units.

You may choose RELT30000 with no pre-requisites **OR** you can choose PHIL30030 as long as you have taken 40 credits of PHIL units in Year 2 and you have an overall minimum GPA of 60 in Year 2.

If you fail to meet the pre-requisites, **then you must choose RELT30000.**
