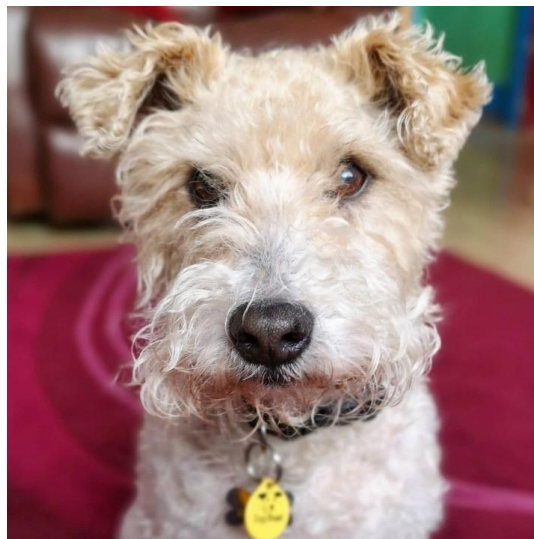
Dear University of Manchester staff,
