Parents with babies approximately one month of age who are referred to an audiologist from the newborn hearing screening programme will be invited to participate in SEQaBOO Manchester during their consultation.

- Parents will be given a SEQaBOO study pamphlet during their consultation with the audiologist.
- The pamphlet includes a [link](#) to the online participant information sheet and consent form.
- If parents would like to participate they can sign up to the study by completing the online consent form and baseline survey which will take less than 10 minutes to complete.
- It is preferable for both parents to enrol in the study but one parent can take part if the other parent can't or doesn't wish to participate.

A family medical history will be collected at 6 months from each parent in the study.

Each parent will fill in an online questionnaire when their baby is:
