

Between 2013/14 and 2019/20 the School saw overall growth of students enrolled on SoSS programs of 12% with the largest increase coming from the postgraduate-taught cohort with a 40% growth, followed by PGDR at 30% and UGRD at 8%. However, between 2019/20 and 2020/21 we have seen large growth in Undergraduate (14%) and postgraduate taught (62%) cohorts. This has been driven by much higher admissions than expected during covid-19. Postgraduate research on the other hand had dropped slightly by 7%



Course Enrollments and Headcount




Student Headcount by Academic Career - 2020/21




As with previous years, The majority of SoSS students are domestic in origin with China accounting for the largest share of non-EU international students.

Student Headcount by Country of Domicile Grouping 2020/21




Top 10 Countries of Domicile for non-Eu Students 2020/21




The School's ethnicity mix is significantly higher than national averages (87 % white as of the 2011 census). The largest driver of this is students whose ethnic identity is Chinese and who make up 26% of the student body (versus 0.69% of the UK population). 
SoSS Full School Granular Ethnicity Mix 2020/21





SoSS Full School Ethnicity Mix 2020/21




Overall the School attracts more female than make students with female students accounting for 59% of the student body across all combined academic levels. The highest proportion of female students within a cohort is Criminology PGT where they account for 88 % of the 58 students in that group. Conversely the lowest representation for female students is in Social Statistics PGT where they account f or 29% of the 45 students in that group.












Undergraduate Attainment by Top Line Ethnicity




Undergraduate Attainment by Top Line Ethnicity UK Domicile




PGDT Attainment by Top Line Ethnicity




PGDT Attainment by Top Line Ethnicity UK Domicile




Undergraduate Attainment by % Within Top Line Ethnic Group




Undergraduate Attainment by % Within Top Line Ethnic Group Uk Domicile



PGDT Attainment by % Within Top Line Ethnic Group




PGDT Attainment by % Within Top Line Ethnic Group UK Domicile



2020/21 Breakdown of Social Sciences Staff by Granular Ethnicity




2020/21 Topline Breakdowns of Ethnicty By School Roles






2020/21 % Of Roles by Gender Across School



2020/21 % Of Role by Gender by Department : Research




2020/21 % Of Role by Gender by Department : Lecturer


