Title of Session	Subject Spotlight: Medicine – Can you die from a broken heart?			
Description:	We often hear about people in the news that supposedly "died of a broken heart". But can this really happen? This workshop covers the so called "Broken Heart Syndrome", also called Takotsubo Cardiomyopathy, how it arises and how we treat it. The workshop also covers basic heart anatomy. It is aimed at those with some existing understanding of the Heart (ie Biology A-level students).
