Project Outline

IPPR North annually publishes the State of the North report which provides an in-depth overview of the year that was for the north of England (North West, North East, and Yorkshire & the Humber). Each year's report looks at a theme in particular. Previous themes have included: the future of devolution, economic resilience, the millennial powerhouse, and last year's set out a progressive vision for levelling up the North in the context of Covid-19. This year, the theme for examination is being developed, but is likely to focus on an economic theme. The report will examine key publicly available data to provide a dashboard of metrics to tell the story of the year, provide insight on the impact of the pandemic, and point towards the foundations of the North's economic recovery and future.
