## **Project Outline**

We currently monitor the Greater Manchester "A Bed Every Night" scheme which provides us with anonymised data on homeless residents across all 10 Councils. This provided us with limited data on presenting needs and how long people stayed in temporary accommodation. We use a few Key Performance Indicators and would like help to explore what else the data could tell us. Then it would be even better if this could be compared against MHCLG National data to see how GM compares to other areas, such as the rough sleeping data for England.
