Project Outline

We currently attempt to analyse our 40,000 families via excel, as we bid for system improvements. We can demonstrate pattern for the full cohort which doesn't tell a great story in terms of attendance. We would really benefit from support understanding family typology a little better. If families meet 2 criteria instead of 6, do we have greater success. If domestic abuse is present in the household, how do the results differ etc?

Each GM Local Authority supply us with the anonymised linked data to show when families started the programme, which of the 6 headline criteria they meet (Crime, attendance, safeguarding, finance, domestic abuse and health) For attendance data, we are provided with the % of attendance per term, back to 2014. We then have to calculate which results are 12 months before intervention, during and 12 months after intervention. We can average this out for the full cohort and it shows mixed results. We would really like to explore further to understand what type of families we have success with and which we struggle to improve the attendance with.
