

Uni research seeks young deaf people

ACADEMICS at Edinburgh University are asking for deaf young people to take part in research.

The study, in partnership with Manchester University and funded by the National Deaf Children's Society, will assess the early experiences of young people who are deaf or suffer from hearing loss and how this affects their adult lives.

Lead author Alys Young said: "The lives of deaf young people in the 21st century offer more possibilities than ever before. But we need to understand what will make a difference for them in fulfilling their potential."
