- Basic Understanding of data sources and how to access

- Experience/understanding of equality characteristics data
- Understanding and reading around the challenge of the use of 'working class' as a definition

Queen Bee Coaching is about providing coaching to women who have demonstrated leadership to improve their skills and confidence, move into positions of power and accelerate their positive impact on society.
