

## Why Study Presentation Teacher Sheet

### Required materials

Post-it notes/ scraps of paper – 1 per student (*necessary; for perception task*)

Whiteboard & whiteboard pens (*necessary; for class Elmo task*)

Pens – 1 per student (*optional; for Elmo task*)

Red, green, blue and yellow post-its/paper scraps – 1 of each colour per student (*optional; for final quiz*)

### Quiz instructions (Quizizz)

1. Copy and paste the link on Slide 25 (below) into a browser window:  
<https://quizizz.com/join/quiz/5fabeeab7a15e1001bc88c0b/start?studentShare=true>
2. Where it says 'Settings' – I recommend deselecting 'timer' (so that you have time to decide as a class what the answer is), as well as 'powerups' (these are just unnecessary and distracting). You can also select which category of memes you see between questions
3. Click the green 'Start' button
4. You should see a countdown and then the first quiz question. Some music may play which you can turn off in the bottom left hand corner if you like
5. I recommend reading out the questions and answer options, and having audio on for satisfying sounds when you select the answers!

### *Class play options:*

1. The answers are multiple choice and displayed in coloured squares, so you can use the coloured post-its/paper scraps to have students hold up the colour of what they think the correct answer is as you go through the quiz
2. Run through the answer options verbally to the whole class and have students raise their hands for what they think the correct answer is
