SUPPORT FOR SCHOOLS

AT PRIMARY LEVEL

- Free training exploring how Latin and Greek root words can help decode English vocabulary

- Free training and resources to teach Latin and Greek at any level from beginners to A Level
- Free training and resources to support the teaching of etymology through Latin and Greek word roots
