<b>Title of Session</b>	<b>Subject Spotlight: ICT – Understanding Information and Communication Technology for Development (ICT4D)</b>
<b>Description:</b>	In this workshop, I explain to you what Information and Communication Technology for Development (ICT4D) means. Just briefly, this is a field of study that explores how various technologies such as mobile phones, radio, satellite, drones, etc. can be used to improve lives in environments without enough basic infrastructure such as electricity or internet. I also share with you the different routes you can take if you wish to study in this areas
