The Manchester Access Programme (MAP) is The University of Manchester's flagship widening participation programme for local post-16 students who meet specific academic and background criteria. MAP aims to support entry to The University of Manchester, or to another research-intensive university, through the completion of a portfolio of work that demonstrates specific knowledge and skills. To be eligible for the benefits of the programme, students who are on MAP must:

- Adhere to the MAP Student Charter
- Successfully complete all compulsory MAP modules, which includes our Launch module, Research and Referencing Skills module and University Life Conference module.
- Pass their MAP Academic Assignment
- Attend two meetings with their Academic Tutor

The majority of events, workshops and activities will be delivered online. However, as coronavirus restrictions are eased, some may be held at The University of Manchester's main Oxford Road campus. Full details of each event / activity will be sent to students on the programme via email or newsletter.

When offered a place on MAP, students will be allocated to either the Medicine, Dentistry or General Strand. Please note that once on the programme, students **CANNOT** change strands under any conditions.
