



## DEVELOPMENT OF A 12-MONTH LEARNING PROGRAMME TO SUPPORT PROVISIONALLY REGISTERED PHARMACISTS (PRPs) WORKING IN COMMUNITY PHARMACY PRACTICE

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## **Background**

Commissioned by HEE to provide support for the 2019/20 cohort of PRPs whose training and registration was disrupted by COVID-19 pandemic. Enabling them to transition from preregistration through provisional registration to fully registered pharmacists

## **Description of work**

Develop and evaluate a 12-month vocational programme mapped to the HEE Interim **Foundation Pharmacist** Programme (IFPP) learning outcomes. Taking a blended learning approach to support PRPs to identify good areas of practice and reflect on development opportunities





## **Proposed evaluation**

Evaluate the impact of the programme to support PRPs to meet competence against the IFPP learning outcomes.

Data will be gathered using online surveys with Likert-type and free text questions
