



Audio-Visual System User Guide: Dry Teaching Lab 2nd Floor Engineering Building B

Space overview:

This lab features two projectors with screens dropping in front of the partitioned wall. Control panels are positioned on the columns at each side of the lab.

Projector Control Panels:

1 Display Power

The display ON and OFF buttons power the relevant projector on or off. The buttons illuminate to show the status of the projector or flash to indicate that it is warming or cooling. The associated electric projection screen will lower when the projector is powered on and retract when powered off.

2 Volume

There is no audio system in this lab so this dial is non-functional.

3 Sources

The source buttons are used to select from the available sources:

HDMI: HDMI input plate next to the control buttons. Connect your device with a HDMI cable and select this source to use.

Solstice: Mersive Solstice wireless collaboration and display system. On selecting this source, the screen will display the connection details and security code needed to do this. For more details on how to use the Solstice system visit: www.solstice.,manchester.ac.uk

Link: Selecting this will display a HDMI source connected to the other projector.
