- **List of Authors (including supervisors) with presenting author in bold**
- **Background**
- **Research Problem**
- **How did you approach the problem?**
- **Results**
- **Conclusions**
- **Future work**

To be eligible, you must be able to attend the face-to-face sessions of the event. Please also include your role (e.g. PhD student, Post Doc, Fellow) and make sure your supervisor is aware of your submission.

Should your abstract be shortlisted for a poster presentation, you will receive instructions and a template to use to produce your poster. This will need to be returned to us electronically and we will print it for you ready to present at the face-to-face event.
