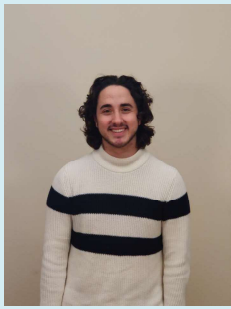


A week in the life of our PPE student, Santiago
