




What we're doing right now...

Open Research Strategic Action Plan 2021-23

- 1. Develop the processes, systems, and skills to pilot a new blended programme of open research training resources with the aim of sustainably scaling up the provision across the organisation.
- 2. Develop the digital identity of the new Office for Open Research providing a single access point for all open research support provision across the University
- 3. Develop a clear communication strategy and campaign, which defines our open research ambitions, and a survey to help shape the future direction of the programme
- 4. Facilitate greater internal collaboration through maximising the utility of existing commercial data sources and in-house technologies
- 5. Training and guidance on the responsible use of metrics in research assessment; advocating for responsible metrics principles throughout the University; monitor and report on progress in implementing responsible metrics.
- 6. In dialogue with academic leaders and communities we will develop an Open Research Indicator Framework which will allow all parts of the University to measure progress against responsible and contextually relevant goals.
- 7. Create and publicise guidelines, policies, and practices for sharing protocols, methodology, and code under open-source licenses
- 8. Develop a strategy and action plan for responsibly transitioning from a subscription based "big-deal" journal model to an Open Access publishing model.
- 9. Develop data publishing services underpinned by the implementation of a new data repository for the University
- 10. Embed best practice in data management across the University by piloting a new Data Stewardship model



Service Level Operational Plans

- 1. Implement the new UKRI Open Access Policy
- 2. Support Renegotiations with Elsevier
- 3. Preparing for the busiest time of the year for data management plan submissions and review
- 4. Implementing a new tool which will find and present datasets published by UoM researchers in their Pure Research Explorer profile
