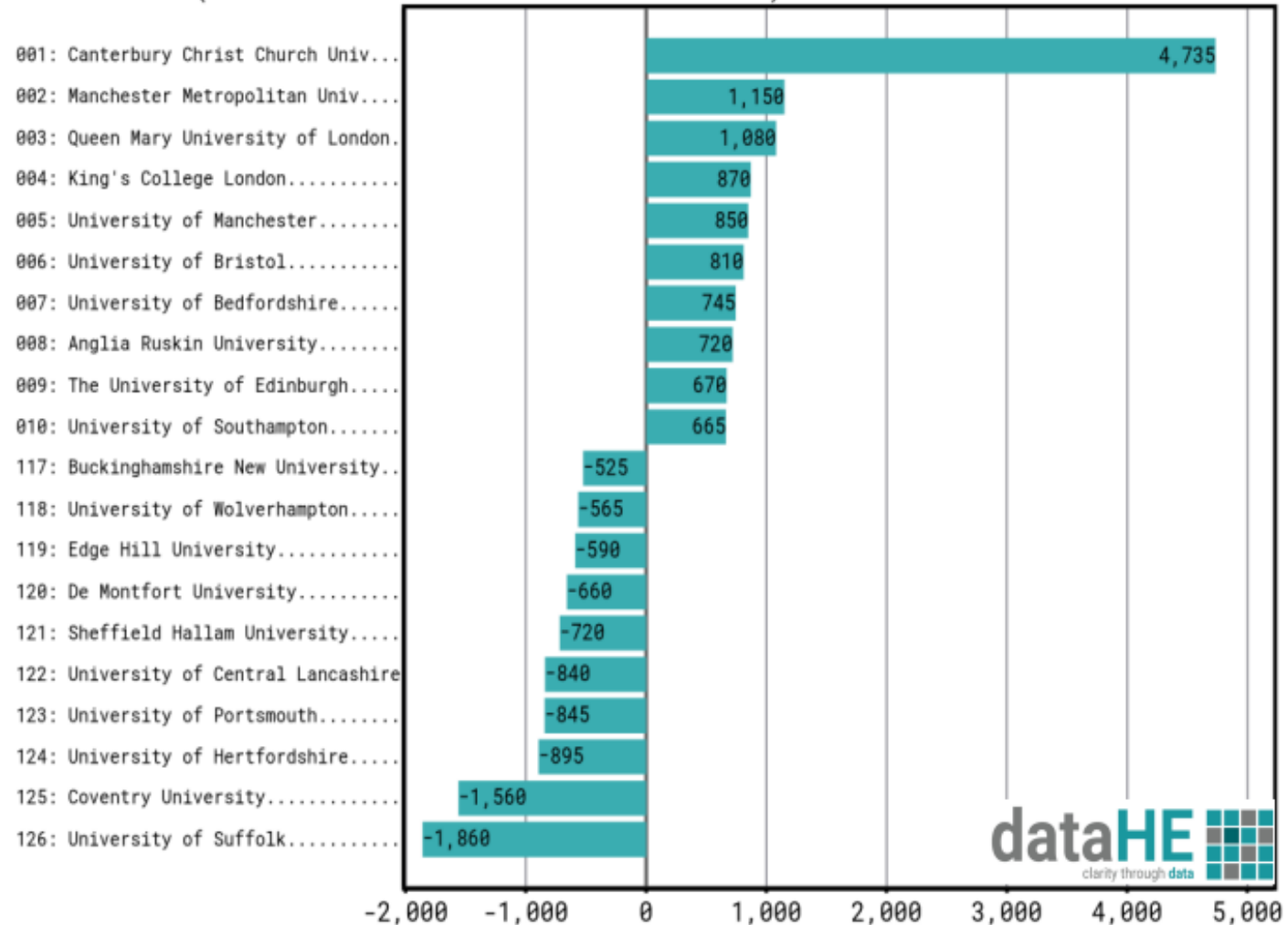

UCAS 2021 End of Cycle Data

- Another record year for higher grades – putting pressure on University admissions processes.
- As the 18 year old population increases, 7% more UK 18 year olds were placed at UK universities
- 81% of students gained a place in their first-choice university or college (up from 76%).
- Demand for Nursing and allied health courses remains strong.

UK students(Providers with data from 2010 to 2021)

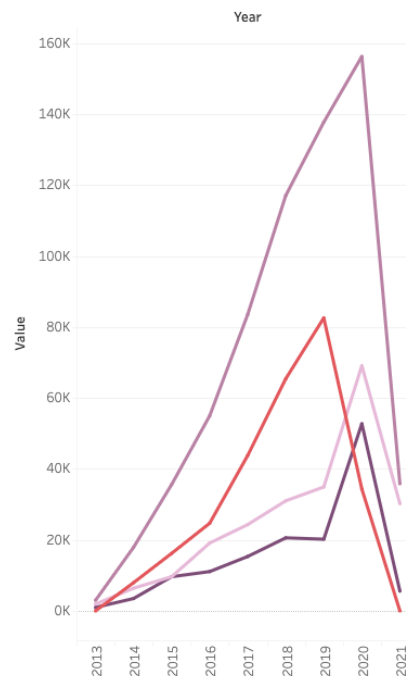
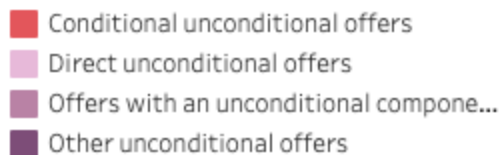


The end of the unconditional?

- Reversal of recent growth in 'conditional unconditional' offer making.
- Ban on 'conditional unconditional' offers has lapsed – no longer regulatory oversight.
- An uneasy truce – will these offer making practices return?

Application for 2022 entry

- UCAS on-time application data to be published next week.
- Notable increase in students from the 2021 cycle reapplying.
- Greater certainty regarding likely levels of attainment in A-levels – midpoint between 2021 and pre-pandemic levels.
- Greater certainty around standards will results in adjustments to offer making and confirmation strategies.
