Project Outline

The project will support the Central Analysis and Insight Team in the delivery of cross-cutting high-priority analysis at the Home Office. As the team work on short-term projects the successful candidate will be required to pick up a high demand project based on business needs.

Current data-focused project work includes mapping Russian and Ukrainian populations in the UK, analysis of the department's gender pay gap, and detailed analysis of the department's people survey results. Other projects have included regression analysis of police recorded crime data and statistical analysis of the criminal justice system process.
