#### Desirable:

- Some knowledge of or interest in social enterprise, the social economy, or community wealth building
- An ability to use Tableau would be helpful

## **Project Outline**

The <u>GM Social Enterprise Advisory Group</u> was set up 'to advise on how to help create a social enterprise sector which contributes towards greater productivity, flexibility and agility in our economy'. The Group drafted a Plan for social enterprises to thrive, which focusses on 4 'enablers'. This project will focus on the first of these:

 Improving our understanding of social enterprise and its contribution to the GM economy

#### This placement will involve:

- Mapping the status of the sector focusing on economic, social & ethical value, utilising common metrics and building from existing data to help differentiate social enterprises
- Building an understanding of the sector needs & aspirations, clarifying each stage of the journey & what success looks like
- Work with GMCA and social enterprise colleagues to create a GM "Thriving Social Enterprise Index"
