PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units, you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any Core courses);
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester;
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester;
- Please note that, in addition to the courses listed below, you will be enrolled on the following course units; SALC11230 -SALC Health & Safety Induction and SALC11260- SALC Academic Malpractice.

HELPFUL HINTS:

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G. HART10051. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2

2a: Choosing Minor in Digital Humanities

As a single honours student in SALC you have the option to study the minor in **Digital Humanities**. Taking this minor allows you to explore the subject area, whilst still allowing you to complete your single honours degree. At the end of the first year, you can choose to continue with the minor in years two and three, and have the subject feature in your degree title if you wish. Alternatively, if you decide to drop the minor, you can still make use of free choice credits in years two and three.
