PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any core courses);
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester;
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester;

HELPFUL HINTS:

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G. HART20701 is a first semester unit.. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
- ✓ To enrol on any of the course units outlined in your programme structure use the Self Service area of Campus Solutions
