Scope

This policy seeks to provide guidance on the usage of kitchens and social spaces within the following buildings, historically referred to as MECD.

- Engineering Building A
- Engineering Building B
- Oddfellows Hall
- York Street Building

General principles

Users of the kitchens will be provided with;

- Cutlery set
- Washing up liquid
- Sponges
- Dishwasher tablets
- Drying rack
- Paper towel
- Mugs for use when hosting visitors

Users of the kitchens are expected to provide;

- Mug for personal use
- Crockery
- Tea and coffee
- Milk

It is suggested that users of the kitchen create a charter that agrees how maintenance of the kitchen is shared. Ideas could include;

- Shared agreements on cleaning
- Shared kitty for the purchase of tea, coffee and milk

Users of the kitchens and social spaces are kindly requested to;

- Keep personal items such as mugs and plates in individual lockers
- Keep kitchen equipment clean, wiping up any spillages after use
- Report any breakages or problems as soon as possible
- Be respectful and considerate of other users of the space

Failure to maintain the kitchens and social spaces will unfortunately result in the removal of these facilities.
