Travel

- Use the 147 bus between campuses.
- Rent out your car when it's not in use with Karshare
- <u>Charge your electric car on campus</u>
- Use the University's <u>interest-free loans</u> to buy public transport season-tickets, bikes, or cycles
- Commute to work by purchasing a bike via the cycle to work scheme
- Use the on campus safe places to store cycles and bikes
- Don't delay in <u>submitting pre-approved staff expenses</u>
- Sign up for free cycling insurance with the Serious Cycle Scheme
