## International Collaboration

This is a dual degree programme in Clinical Pharmacy involving collaboration between two top universities in China and the United Kingdom (UK).

## Dual Awards

Upon successful completion of the programme, graduates leave with two BSc degrees in clinical pharmacy, one from China Pharmaceutical University (CPU) and one from University of Manchester (UoM).

# STUDENT PATHWAY

What does the BSc Clinical Pharmacy Programme look like?

## YEAR 1 & 2

You will be studying the foundations of pharmacy at China Pharmaceutical University (CPU) with some taught units being delivered by staff from University of Manchester (UoM).



September 2021

You start your studies at CPU.



February to June 2022

Some units will be taught by UoM staff at CPU.



Spring 2023

To progress to years 3 & 4 at UoM, you will need to successfully pass all units from years 1 and 2 in CPU and meet other entry criteria specified in the programme handbook.



September 2022

The 2nd year at CPU starts.



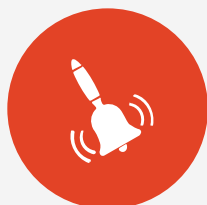
September 2023

You will arrive in Manchester.



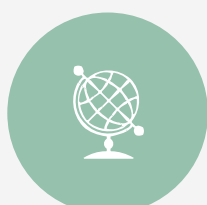
Summer 2023

Summer 2025

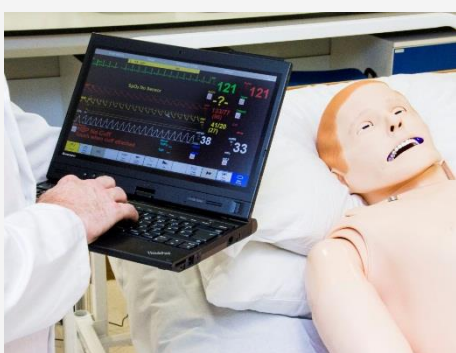
## Lectures

## Group tasks

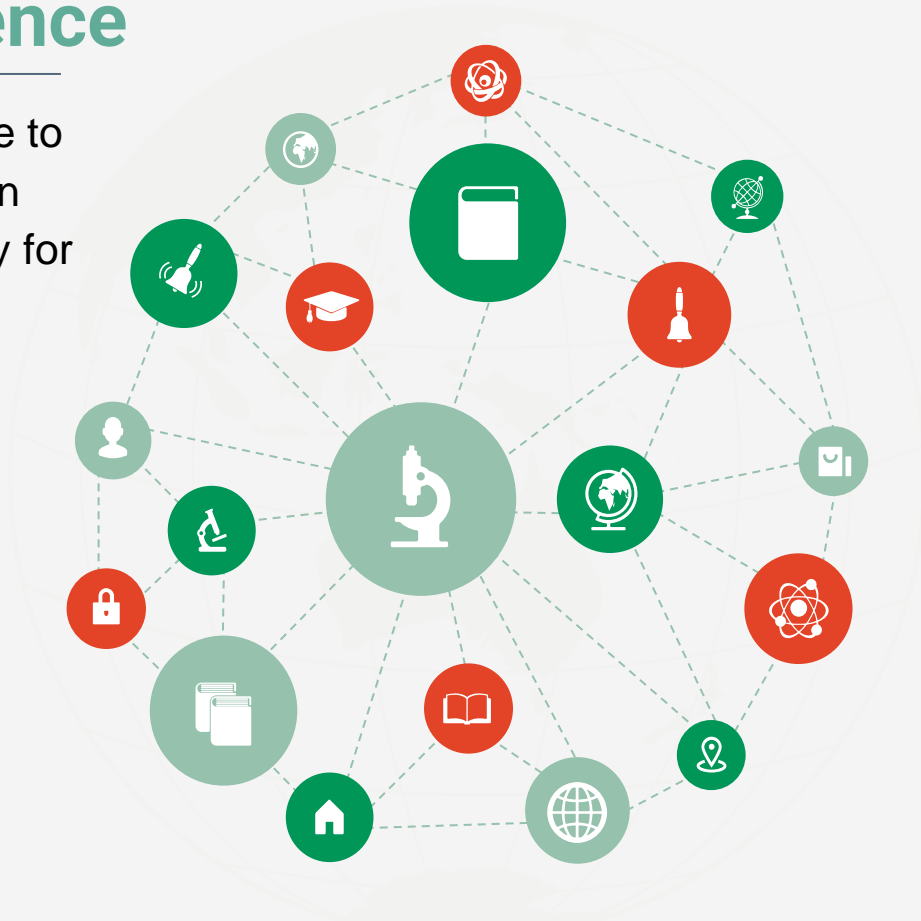
Working together on small group tasks to support your communication skills via teamwork
