#### **International Collaboration**

This is a dual degree programme in Clinical Pharmacy involving collaboration between two top universities in China and the United Kingdom (UK).

Upon successful completion of the programme, graduates leave with two BSc degrees in clinical pharmacy, one from China Pharmaceutical University (CPU) and one from University of Manchester (UoM).

What does the BSc Clinical Pharmacy Programme look like?

#### **YEAR 1 & 2**

You will be studying the foundations of pharmacy at China **Pharmaceutical** University (CPU) with some taught units being delivered by staff from University of Manchester (UoM).

#### Spring 2023

The 2nd year at CPU starts.



#### September 2023

You will arrive in Manchester.



#### Summer 2023

Before arriving at Manchester, you will study units delivered by UoM staff in China.



#### September 2024

The 2<sup>nd</sup> year at UoM starts.



#### Summer 2025

You will study units delivered by UoM staff back in China.


