## **Programme of Study instructions 25-26**

A Programme of Study (PoS) is a tool that allow users to view a timetable in a grid format. They operate in a similar fashion to your personal "Publish" timetables that you may use during the teaching period. PoS are directly linked to Syllabus Plus (S+ is the timetabling software used) and so any update made in S+ will automatically update the PoS within the hour. You can view the following information:

- Programme timetables
- Individual course unit timetables
- Location timetables

## How to access a programme of study timetable for 25-26

- 2. Select whether you wish to view locations, programmes, or individual units (locations should be ignored until timetables are officially published every year).
- 3. Select your desired department
- 4. Select your desired location, programme or course unit.
- 5. Select the specific weeks you wish to view. Semester 1 or semester 2 can also be selected.
- 6. Click on 'view timetable'.
