


CREATIVE ACTIVISTS

This autumn we are relaunching our Creative Activists project. We're looking for people aged 18 - 25 who are seeking to create powerful acts of sharing and connection with local communities to join the group.

Participants will explore stories from our collection connected to the Second World War and the Holocaust. They will share these stories with audiences as part of Holocaust Memorial Day, as well as look to elicit positive change in their own communities through art and activism.

The project will culminate in participants curating an open day and exhibition at the museum on Holocaust Memorial Day 2024.

- We will be meeting weekly at Manchester Jewish Museum. Meetings will be held on Wednesdays, 4-6PM.
