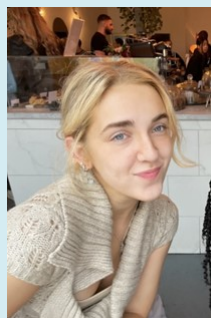


A week in the life of our Social Anthropology student, Ellen
