<b>1. Activate your University IT account</b> You have been sent an email from do-not-reply@manchester.ac.uk with instructions on how to do this. Check your junk folder.	18th March
<b>2. Accept your MAP offer online</b> You have been sent an email from do-not-reply@manchester.ac.uk with instructions on how to do this. Check your junk folder.	18th March
<b>3. Complete the MAP registration form</b> This will be sent to you from map@manchester.ac.uk and may take up to 2 working days to receive. Here you will sign up for your first MAP event on either 3rd or 4th April.	25th March
<b>4. Access Blackboard</b> Go to <a href="https://online.manchester.ac.uk">online.manchester.ac.uk</a> , click on 'organisations', and 'Manchester Access Programme 2024'. Log in using your university username and password. Blackboard is our online learning portal and you will need to access it to participate in MAP.	29th March
<b>5. Complete the MAP induction on Blackboard</b>	29th March
