

#### **Call for Patient Involvement**

# Do you/have you had any of the following conditions?

- Chronic fungal lung infection (such as Aspergillosis or Cryptococcosis)
- HIV and you have experienced complications due to infections in the past
- Parasitic infection which required hospitalisation. Including Malaria, Trypanasomiasis, Leishmaniasis.
- Cystic fibrosis which has been made worse by infections more than 3 times in a year
- COPD which has been made worse by infections more than 3 times in a year
- Meningitis, or parents of children that have had meningitis (bacterial or viral)
- Sepsis due to infection, for example caused by Staphylococcus aureus or Escherichia coli
- A Gut infection called *Clostridium difficile*, which you developed whilst in hospital
- Tuberculosis
- COVID-19 infection that required hospitalisation/ ICU admission.

## Are you willing to tell us about your healthcare experiences?

A patient's perspective of a condition is often very different to a scientists. By talking to university master's students who are studying Medical Microbiology, you could help them to understand what it is like to experience one of these conditions, understand the condition from a patient perspective, and understand the impact that their future work and research could have on people's lives.

#### Who are we looking for and what do we need you to do?

We are looking for 4 people who would be happy to talk about their experiences of one of the conditions above. We will ask you to talk to 4 separate groups of students. There will be up to 15 students in each group.
