The Artists

In 2019, Mariya performs a cover of a Bulgarian folklore song, arranged by the legendary Stefan Mutafchiev. She decides to sing and layer all the vocal parts by herself. The video quickly becomes viral, so she decides to perform two more songs, this time with her own arrangements. She sings one of the songs all by herself again, but the other was done with the help of her sister Vanya and the sixteen-year-old singer Hristina Yosifova.

Shortly after Mariya started to get invited to perform live and so she needed to find singers to join her on the stage. For the alt voice the choice was obvious - her sister Vanya, who is not a professional musician herself but gladly accepted the invitation to join the a cappella trio that Mariya had in mind. For the second soprano voice, however, Mariya needed help finding the right person so she asked for help from Gancho Gavazov who is the conductor of the folklore choir in one of the two national folklore schools in Bulgaria - NSFA "Shiroka Luka". He told her about Asya Pincheva, who had already graduated from the same school.

It was the perfect match. Asya, although already quite busy with various different musical projects, gladly accepted her invitation. The three of them got to work straight away and started recording new songs which were later widely praised and loved by the listeners & audience.

Due to the unforeseen circumstances that took place in 2020 all over the world and later on Mariya's birth of her child, the trio had to postpone their performances, but as things started to get better, Mariya, Asya & Vanya have started working on their debut album which is set to be released soon.
