

### Internet Access Grant

Your scholarship includes an **Internet Grant of up to GBP 390**.

This grant helps you pay for internet access during your studies.

We know that:

- Internet can be expensive in many countries
- and it can be difficult to access in rural areas

You can use this money to help you get online.

For example:

- Buy a modem
- Buy a router
- Pay for internet equipment

This is a **one-time payment**.

It is meant to cover internet costs for your **full study period**.

### How to Request the Grant

If you want to request this grant, please email us **as soon as possible**.

In your email, tell us:

- How you plan to use the money (for example, buying a modem)

We will review your request and let you know if it is approved.

### Proof of Purchase (Required)

To pay the grant, we need **one** of the following:

- A **proforma invoice** (for something you plan to buy), or
- A **receipt** (for something you have already bought)

### Important note:

- The total cost on the invoice or receipt **does not need to be the same as the grant amount**.
  - The grant will cover costs **up to GBP 390**.

### Bank Details Needed

To send the money to you, we need your bank details.

Please provide a typed letter from your bank on official bank letterhead (handwritten letters or letters on plain paper are not acceptable).

The letter must include:

- Bank name and full address
- Your full name (account holder)
- Your full address (as registered with the bank)
- Bank account number
- SWIFT / BIC code
- IBAN number (if available)
- Routing number (if available)
- Sort code (if available)
- Account currency

**Important:**

- Please **confirm that your bank account can receive payments in GBP or USD**
- The letter **must be typed**, not handwritten
- Upload all documents to our **secure [Dropbox folder](#)**
- **Do not send documents by email attachment**

Once we receive everything, we will send the money **directly to your bank account**.
