## Recruiter Hot Tips

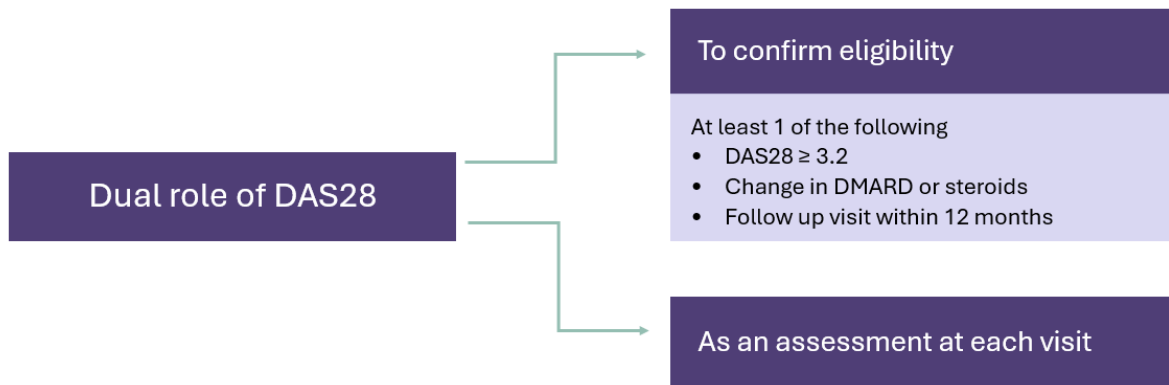
- Jean, Tameside General – Give your patients a heads up before with PIS mailouts and adverts in the clinic
- Jo, Bolton One – put the patient adverts everywhere – including the toilets!

## Patient Screening Logs

Provide a snapshot of data for **all patients** approached and given a PIS at **all sites** at **set dates** during the trial:

- You’ll get a **request** at roughly monthly intervals with a defined **submission date**
- Please submit **just 1 per cycle** as close to the **submission date** as possible
