

Our accommodation walking tour gives you a chance to view a selection of our accommodation in Victoria Park. The tour includes halls owned by the University and ones we lease from partner organisations, as well as examples of en suite/shared bathrooms, catered/self-catered, and flat/corridor style accommodation.

Our accommodation is open from 10am until 4pm sharp. Unfortunately, as our halls are occupied, we cannot allow access to anyone who arrives outside these times.

KUUIL

- From the Whitworth Building, head south down Oxford Road
- Pass Whitworth Park Hall on your right
- Turn right onto Denmark Road
- After 200m, arrive at **Denmark Road Hall**
- Leave Denmark Road Hall and turn left, back towards Oxford Road
- Turn right onto Oxford Road and continue past Whitworth Park
- Cross Oxford Road and turn left onto Rusholme Place
- Arrive at Rusholme Place Hall
- Leave Rusholme Place and turn left
- You will shortly arrive at Burkhardt House and Hulme Hall
- Leave Hulme Hall and turn right along Oxford Place
- Cross Upper Brook Street and Hathersage Road
- Arrive at Brook Hall
- Leave Brook Hall, cross Upper Brook Street and walk along Hathersage Road
- Turn right when Hathersage Road meets Oxford Road and carry on back to The University of Manchester campus



ABRIDGED WALKING TOUR

If you want, you can use public transport to view Rusholme Place, Hulme Hall and Burkhardt House. The three halls are 15 minutes by bus, and we recommend allowing 45 minutes to view all three. A single ticket for the bus will cost £2.

You can board the following buses at the University Shopping Centre: 42, 42A, 42B, 42C or 142. Ride 3 stops until Oxford Road/St Mary's (Stop U), which is in front of Tesco and Lidl.

> There are a small number of blue badge parking spaces at Hulme Hall and Burkhardt House.



- Our accommodation is currently occupied, so please be mindful of this when viewing our halls.
- Our show flats are occupied, so please don't go through drawers, wardrobes, or other storage areas without permission.
- Students living in Hulme Hall will be having their brunch from 11:30am to 1pm, so it may not be possible to view the dining area at this time.
