
Overall Systems Process Map for Timetabling



This is a flow map showing the data transfer stages relating to timetabling.




Student Enrolment Process Map for Timetabling

This is a flow map showing the data transfer stages relating to student enrolments to timetabling. The following pages demonstrate example scenarios of when the data exchanges occur and when they become visible.



Student Enrolment Process Map for Timetabling



Example scenarios: Student Enrolment to Timetable System

Example 1

- Student enrols onto a course unit at 9:00am Monday morning, via Campus Solutions.
- At 6:00pm on Monday the data feed between Campus Solutions and Syllabus+ runs, transferring the student's new enrolment data. Depending on the amount of enrolment data to transfer, this can take up to three hours.
- The student then appears on Activity Templates in Syllabus+, for the new course units they have enrolled for.
- From 2:00am Tuesday the single-group auto-allocate job runs to attach the student to all their new activities in which the whole cohort attend (e.g. Lectures).
- P&C Teams can allocate the student to any multi-group activities (e.g. seminar groups) from Tuesday morning.
- Once allocated in Syllabus+, the activities appear on the student's personal timetable immediately.

Example 2

- Student enrols onto a course unit at 7:00pm Wednesday evening, via Campus Solutions.
- This is not captured in the 6:00pm Wednesday evening data transfer but will be in the 6:00pm Thursday evening data transfer instead.
- The student then appears on Activity Templates in Syllabus+, for the new course units they have enrolled for.
- From 2:00am on Friday the single-group auto-allocate job runs to attach the student to all their new activities in which the whole cohort attend (e.g. Lectures).
- P&C Teams can allocate the student to any multi-group activities (e.g. seminar groups) from Friday morning.
- Once allocated in Syllabus+, the activities appear on the student's personal timetable immediately.

Example 3

- Student enrols onto a course unit at 8:00pm Friday evening, via Campus Solutions.
- This is not captured in the 6:00pm Friday evening data transfer but will be in the 6:00pm Saturday evening data transfer instead.
- The student then appears on Activity Templates in Syllabus+, for the new course units they have enrolled for.
- From 2:00am on Sunday the single-group auto-allocate job runs to attach the student to all their new activities in which the whole cohort attend (e.g. Lectures).
- P&C Teams can allocate the student to any multi-group activities (e.g. seminar groups) when they return to work after the weekend, on Monday.
- Once allocated in Syllabus+, the activities appear on the student's personal timetable immediately.
