## Louder than Words Focus Group Call Out

"The use of stop-and-search powers by police in Greater Manchester has increased by 25 times the national average. More than 100 people in the region were stopped and searched by police every day last year, new figures show." BBC 12 June 2024

- Would you be happy to share your stories in this focus group?
- Do you want to look at ways in which your lived experience can help others?

We are looking for a group up to ten people, 18-30 years with lived experience of being stopped and searched.

This group will act as a focus group working in response to artist Barbara Walker's series of work called 'Louder than Words', which draws on her son's experience of stop and search. We are looking to develop a resource from the collated stories that may be of benefit to young people and raise awareness to others.

## What will happen?

- The focus group will meet 5 times at the gallery September December 2024
- Sessions led by a local facilitator and an artist with some experience of stop and search.
- One of the sessions is combined with another focus group exploring themes around Windrush
- You will work with the artist to shape a creative resource
- You will receive expenses for attending the sessions up to £15 per meeting

This is an intergenerational project, drawing inspiration from Barbara Walker's two series of work, 'Burden of Proof' and 'Louder than Words' exploring the impact of both 'Windrush' and 'Stop and Search' across local generations.
