

Eligibility

You only need **ONE** of the following (but can have more):

- DAS28 ≥ 3.2 within last 6 months
- Change in DMARD or steroids within last 6 months
- Follow up visit within 12 months

Don't forget - we will collect the DAS28 score at every visit

Please remember to assess the DAS28 score at every visit, including at baseline. We will collect this information even if it isn't used to confirm eligibility
