

Creative workshops: Collaborative Zine-Making

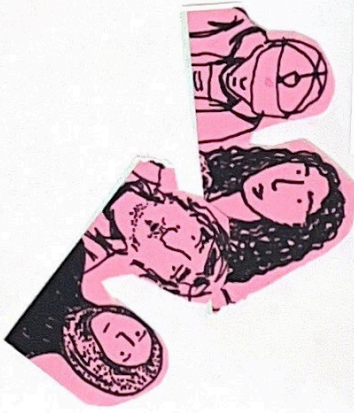
