Over Summer/Autumn 2024 a series of projects have been delivered to improve the experience for students. The work was a collaboration between various teams within the Directorate who ensured the projects were managed whilst the buildings were in use and then ready for the return of students. Thanks to all those involved whether managing the projects, carrying out AV installs, ensuring the work was safe and compliant or helping clean and prepare the spaces ready for use.

The works include:

- Refurbishment of the University Place Entrance Drum
- Creation of a new Cosy Campus and replacement of flooring in Alan Gilbert Learning Commons
- Refurbishment of student accommodation at Whitworth Park
- Creation of an advanced Dental Education Suite in Carys Bannister building
- Conversion of the Kilburn Loading Bay Entrance
- Refurbishment works in 20 central and faculty teaching spaces
- Toilet refurbishments in AV Hill, Alan Turing, Arthur Lewis and Jean McFarlane buildings including creation of Universal/All Gender toilet facilities
- Refurbishment of 1st floor corridors in Martin Harris Centre for Music and Drama
- Refurbishment of student common rooms in Stopford building with of a Cosy Campus on the 3rd floor
