Aim	The aim of the Rosetrees Translational Award is to catalyse translational research that has the potential to deliver patient benefit within 5-10 years. Funding can be used to cover the additional costs associated with the translation of research. The award is for £150K over 2 years and can be used across a broad spectrum of research. Eligibility	Candidates must already have a career establishment/development fellowship from the ERC, UKRI, Royal Society or Wellcome Trust.  Applicants will need to demonstrate that the objectives of their proposal to Rosetrees are unique and distinct to that of their career development fellowship.			
Timing	Candidates can apply anytime after 18 months from the start of their current eligible fellowship. Candidates must be funded for the duration of the Rosetrees-funded award either by their fellowship or another guaranteed funding source. Rosetrees funding cannot be used to fund the salary of the fellow. Applicants must be able to demonstrate a clear path to clinical translation.			
Cost	£150K over 24 months			
Funding	This funding is flexible and is designed to cover additional costs associated with the translation of research. We will consider funding staff salaries (excluding PhD studentships), consumables, consultancy fees, outsourcing to contract research organisations, software/app development, IP landscaping, regulatory approval and other service providers.			
Milestones	Candidate will need to demonstrate progress in measure for translational readiness on a scale 1-9. Further details can be found on our website and the application form.			
Mentoring	Candidate can demonstrate through their existing fellowship how they mentor and develop their team members - reflecting Rosetrees' approach.			
Application	All applications should be made through the Rosetrees Flexigrant Portal.			
Panel	The panel will be chaired by Professor David Lomas and will consist of leading academics from UK universities.			
Selection	Shortlisted candidates will be invited for panel interview. Final selection will be carried out by panel and Rosetrees managment team.
