Student leads on consultations creating management plans, drafting referrals, reviewing pathology results, practice prescribing, actioning hospital correspondence under supervision in preparation for F1.	£3,045 per student for 5 weeks
<b>Year 5</b>	QEPEP - Quality and Evidence Personal Excellence Pathway	1 student for 4 weeks. 2 blocks: 23.03.26 – 17.04.26 20.04.26 – 15.05.26	Student produces a lay document and work report or Quality and Evidence (QE) report. It is optimum for the students to do 3 days of educational activities in the practice. However, the timetable is negotiable between student and supervisor, dependent on the needs of the quality improvement project.	£1,600 per student for 4 weeks
