Getting in touch

Inventories

When you arrive, you'll either find an inventory form in your bedroom listing the items provided in your room and shared areas. Please take a few minutes to check everything is present and in good condition. Note any missing or damaged items on the form and return it to your local reception within 24 hours of arrival. Alternatively you may need to download your halls app to complete their inventory. If you don't complete the inventory, you may be held responsible for any missing or damaged items when you move out.
