

Publishing your course on Canvas


* Unlike Blackboard, [Canvas](#) courses need to be manually published *

Who is responsible for publishing the course?

The unit co-ordinator/course leader is responsible for publishing the course (i.e. making it available to students).

How do I publish my course?

You can quickly publish from your dashboard by simply clicking the **Publish** button on the course card:

You can also publish from the course **Home**. On the top right-hand side of the homepage, look for **Course status**. Click the drop-down menu and select **Publish**. You can also unpublish in the same way. Note, there is no quick unpublish button on course cards in the dashboard.


