practice, peer learning

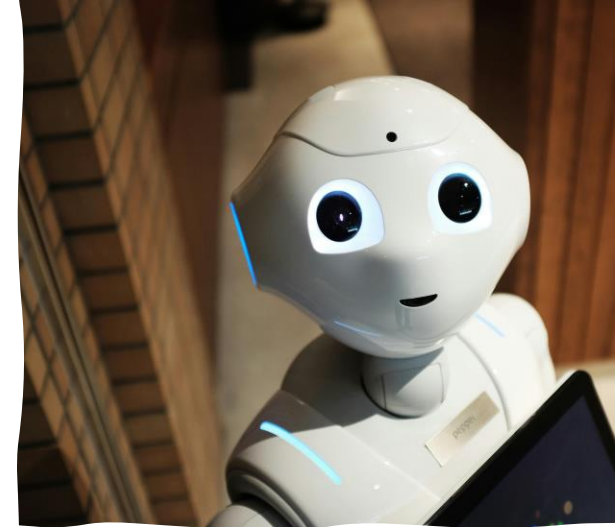

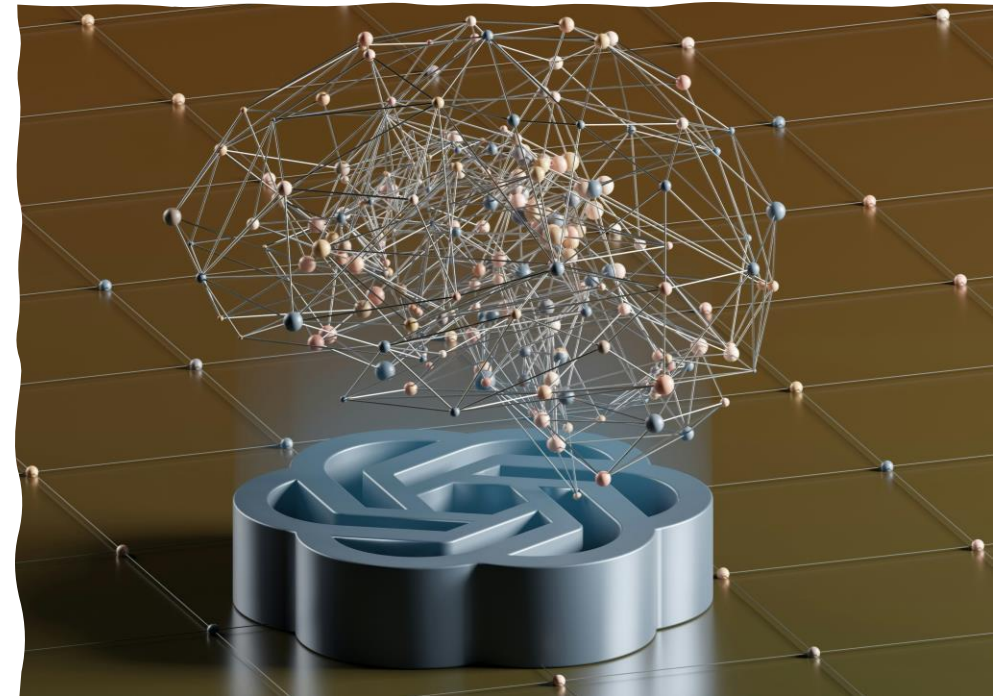
- 1st assessment –Elon –forward thinker or attention seeker?
