Internship Structure and Aims

- Duration: 3-month paid internship.
- Participants: two second-year SLT students.
- Core aims: to provide
 opportunities for SLT students
 interested in a potential career
 in academia, and to create
 inclusive mentorship offered to
 students for diversity to be
 represented amongst SLTs.

Real-World Academic Exposure

Key responsibilities:

- Gathering and analyzing student experiences: assessment feedback questionnaire.
- Supporting admissions and outreach events.
- Delivering lectures to Year 1 students.
- Curriculum development: assessment and learning.

Interns Experience and Development

- Personal growth and confidence in academic spaces.
- Insight into academic career pathways.
- Achievements: involvement in further initiatives (e.g., AFHEA applications).
- Overcoming barriers to access (e.g., imposter syndrome, lack of representation).

Lecturer perspectives

- Goals for the first funded internship met
- Also developed a protocol for subsequent internships
 - Second year underway
 - Significant contributions to admission practices
- Longer term goal: to see more under-represented groups in clinical academic setting.
 - Can we do more?

Lecturer perspectives

- Provides structured route for co-production within the programme
- Increases opportunities to develop academic leadership and mentoring skills
- Greater insight into the individual journeys of our students from WP backgrounds
- Increased appreciation for the importance of this work
