Year 3 Academic Units – Semester 1

Unit Title	Description
The Nurse as an Enquirer of Clinical Evidence	This unit develops students' ability to critically appraise and apply research to clinical practice, supporting evidence-based decision-making.
The Nurse as a Facilitator of Learning	This unit prepares students to support the learning of others, including peers, patients, and junior staff, fostering a culture of continuous improvement and education in practice.
